Anders Tegnell

Anders Tegnell, physician and epidemiologist, was State Epidemiologist at the Public Health Agency of Sweden between 2013 and 2022. He led Sweden's response during COVID. His management of the pandemic stood out from the rest of the world, basing Sweden's strategy around maintaining an open society with voluntary guidelines, instead of mandates, lockdowns, school closures, and coercion.

The world's data proves that Sweden's response was correct, with the smallest rise in excess mortality of all developed nations. Moreover, Sweden avoided the severe harms to children found especially in the United States and elsewhere, including suicides, drug abuse, severe psychological damage, learning losses, delayed language development, and more.
